## 4 Nights & 5 Days Itinerary

### Day 1: Arrival in Bangalore - Bangalore Sightseeing

On arrival at Bangalore airport/railway station, you will meet our representative who will transfer you to your hotel. After checking in and freshening up, you will proceed for a half-day sightseeing tour of Bangalore. You will visit some of the famous attractions such as:

- Tipu Sultan's Palace: A magnificent palace built by Tipu Sultan in 1791 as his summer residence. The palace is adorned with beautiful paintings, arches, pillars and balconies.
- Ranganathaswamy Temple: A 16th century temple dedicated to Lord
  Ranganatha, a form of Lord Vishnu. The temple is known for its intricate carvings,
  sculptures and paintings.
- Lal Bagh: A sprawling botanical garden spread over 240 acres. The garden houses over 1800 species of plants, flowers, trees and herbs. It also has a glass house, a lake, a rock garden and a statue of Kempegowda.
- Cubbon Park: A green oasis in the heart of the city covering 300 acres. The park
  has various attractions such as museums, libraries, statues, fountains and
  playgrounds.
- Vidhana Soudha: The seat of the state legislature of Karnataka. The building is an
  impressive example of neo-Dravidian architecture with four domes, a central
  tower and a grand staircase.
- ISKCON Temple: A modern temple complex dedicated to Lord Krishna. The
  temple is one of the largest ISKCON temples in the world and has a gold-plated
  dome, a museum, a theatre, and a restaurant. In the evening, you will return to
  your hotel for an overnight stay.

### DAY 2: Bangalore - Mysore (150 km/3 hours)

After breakfast, you will check out from your hotel and drive to Mysore. En route, you will stop at:

- **Srirangapatna:** The capital of Tipu Sultan's kingdom in the 18th century. The town is famous for its historical monuments such as Daria Daulat Bagh, Gumbaz, Tipu's Fort, and Ranganatha swamy Temple.
- **Channapatna:** A small town known for its wooden toys and handicrafts. You can shop for some colorful and unique souvenirs here.

On reaching Mysore, you will check in to your hotel and relax for some time. In the afternoon, you will visit:

- Mysore Palace: The official residence of the Wodeyar dynasty and one of the
  most splendid palaces in India. The palace is a marvel of Indo-Saracenic
  architecture with domes, turrets, arches, and stained-glass windows. The palace
  also has a museum, a temple, and a gallery.
- Chamundi Hills: A hilltop that offers a panoramic view of Mysore city. The hill is also home to the Chamundeshwari Temple, a 12th-century temple dedicated to Goddess Chamundi, the patron deity of Mysore.
- Brindavan Gardens: A beautiful garden located at the foot of the Krishnaraja
   Sagar Dam. The garden is famous for its musical fountain, illuminated terraces,
   flower beds, and statues. In the evening, you will return to your hotel for an
   overnight stay.

## Day 3: Mysore - Ooty (125 km/3 hours)

 After breakfast, you will check out from your hotel and drive to Ooty. Ooty is a popular hill station in Tamil Nadu and is known for its picturesque landscapes, pleasant climate, and colonial charm. On reaching Ooty, you will check in to your hotel and relax for some time. In the afternoon, you will visit:

- Ooty Lake: A man-made lake created by John Sullivan, the founder of Ooty, in 1824. The lake is surrounded by eucalyptus trees and offers boating and fishing facilities.
- Botanical Garden: A 22-acre garden that showcases a variety of plants, flowers, trees, and ferns. The garden also has a fossilized tree trunk, a glass house, a rose garden, and a monkey puzzle tree.
- Doddabetta Peak: The highest peak in the Nilgiri Hills at an altitude of 2623
  meters. The peak offers a breathtaking view of the surrounding hills, valleys,
  and plains.
- In the evening, you will return to your hotel for an overnight stay.

#### Day 4: Ooty - Coonoor - Ooty

After breakfast, you will proceed for a full-day excursion to Coonoor, a charming hill station located 19 km from Ooty. You will visit some of the attractions such as:

- Sim's Park: A botanical garden that houses over 1000 species of plants, flowers, and trees. The park also has a lake, a rockery, and a rose garden.
- Lamb's Rock: A viewpoint that offers a stunning view of the Coimbatore
  plains, the tea estates, and the forests.
- Dolphin's Nose: A rock formation that resembles a dolphin's nose. The viewpoint offers a spectacular view of Catherine Falls and the Nilgiri Hills.
- Tea Factory and Museum: A place where you can learn about the history and process of tea production. You can also taste and buy some fresh tea here.
   After enjoying the scenic beauty of Coonoor, you will drive back to Ooty for an overnight stay.

## Day 5: Ooty - Bangalore (270 km/6 hours) – Departure

After breakfast, you will check out from your hotel and drive back to Bangalore. On reaching Bangalore, you will be dropped off at the airport/railway station for your onward journey. Your Bangalore Mysore Ooty tour package ends here with sweet memories.
